

ORDINANCE No. 190331

*Authorize a contract with WSP USA for design and surveying services in amount not to exceed \$1,766,410 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The purpose of this project is to help create healthy, connected Neighborhood Centers in the Jade District and Montavilla, so that people can safely reach their daily needs within a 20 minute walk or bike ride, use more mass transit and active transportation, reduce their energy use and mitigate climate change.
2. The project is focused on building and improving critical walking and biking connections to and through the Jade District and Montavilla to serve the multiple existing high concentrations of Environmental Justice and underserved communities.
3. The Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award federal funding to the Portland Bureau of Transportation totaling \$3,200,000, with \$1,158,450 allocated to design phase.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, due to contingencies in the scope.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with WSP in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delay in proceeding with the design of this project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
