

# ORDINANCE No. 149919

An Ordinance creating 4 positions of Credit Relations Representative, abolishing 3 positions of Clerk III and 1 position of Typist-Clerk in the Bureau of Water Works, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That in an effort to reduce the excessive labor turnover in the Revenue Collections area of the Water Bureau, the Bureau of Personnel Services has reviewed the duties and finds that the complexities of the positions warrant a separate classification and, therefore, should be reclassified to Credit Relations Representative.
2. One position of Typist-Clerk and 3 positions of Clerk III can be abolished to provide appropriation for the positions being created.
3. The changes have been approved by the Bureau of Personnel Services.




