

ORDINANCE No. 149924

An Ordinance authorizing application by the Bureau of Parks to the Oregon State Marine Board for a grant estimated at \$76,442.00 for reconstruction of the existing boat ramp at Willamette Park, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon State Marine Board makes grants to local governments for the construction and improvement of boating facilities and related projects.
2. The boat ramp at Willamette Park has deteriorated to an unsafe condition due to erosion of its underwater portion.
3. The grant application will request funds for Phase II of the project in the amount of \$76,442.00 for construction of the boat ramp. Full indirect costs at a rate of 10 percent of eligible costs are included in the grant budget.
4. The grant requests that the State Marine Board fund 50% of the project. Should it be approved, City of Portland general funds would be requested for the remainder of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner-in-Charge shall make application to the Oregon State Marine Board for a grant estimated at \$76,442.00 for reconstruction of a boat ramp at Willamette Park.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the Oregon State Marine Board.
