

ORDINANCE NO. 149925

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to negotiate a contract with General Electric Company for 2400 street lighting luminaires for the Street Lighting Division, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Funding for the Arterial Conversion Project (Phase I) has been appropriated for the Street Lighting Division in both the 1979-80 and 1980-81 budgets, with additional funding from the Oregon Department of Transportation per ordinance No. 149816.
2. On April 16, 1980 the Purchasing Manager published a call for bids for annual supply of luminaires and General Electric Company was the only company filing prequalification documents.
3. The arterial conversion project must be started within the next two (2) months so it will be near completion in the winter months when energy quantities are short and at a premium.
4. For every month the conversion project is delayed it will cost the City approximately \$25,000 for energy.
5. General Electric Company has a luminaire which meets the performance specifications published with the call for bids and is willing to negotiate a unit price contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to negotiate a contract with General Electric Company, PO Box 909, Portland, OR 97207, subject to approval by both the City Attorney and the Street Lighting Division, for 2400 luminaires.
- b. The Auditor and Commissioner of Public Works are authorized to sign the contract with General Electric Company, which will include terms and unit prices. The unit prices shall be subject to Council approval.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants in the negotiated amounts, chargeable to the 1980-81 budget; Street Lighting Fund, Street Lighting Division, 332, 630, when demanded, if presented, and approved by proper authorities.

# ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in the purchase of a supply of street lighting luminaires would postpone starting the arterial conversion project, resulting in additional energy costs; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect, from and after its passage by the Council.
