AMENDING AGREEMENT

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement, Contract No. 15007 on October 27, 1975 for providing custodial services to Annex I and AnnexII;

WHEREAS, the Contractor discontinued custodial services to Annex I at the request of the City;

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the contract may be modified yearly as mutually agreed upon;

WHEREAS, the contract sum and payment should be adjusted to reflect such increased costs to the contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties hereto do agree as follows:

- Contract sum and payment is amended as follows:
- a. Effective July 1, 1980, City shall pay Contractor monthly for furnishing the services covered hereunder the sum of Two Hundred Ninety Seven and 57/100 (\$297.57).
- 2. The most current Portland Consumer Price Index published by the U.S. Department of Labor shall be used as a basis for negotiations, although other factors may be considered.

ORDINANCE NO. 119916

An Ordinance authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 15007 with Mr. C's Janitorial Service, Inc., for the provision of custodial services for the Bureau of Facilities Management by increasing the annual contract payments by \$124.68 for the four months remaining on the contract to reflect cost of living increases, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On October 27, 1975, the City of Portland entered into Contract No. 15007 with Mr. C's Janitorial Service, Inc. to provide custodial services.
- 2. That the agreement provides that the contract price may be modified as mutually agreed upon, on a year to year basis, for a period not to exceed five years.
- 3. That the Contractor's operating costs have increased and the contract sum is based upon operating costs. The basis for the contract price negotiation is the Consumer Price Index as calculated by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the Portland area. Funds for the additional contract payments are contained in the 1980-81 budget of the Bureau of Facilities Management.
- 4. That Contract No. 15007 will expire November 1, 1980 and will be rebid.
- 5. That this adjustment will be in effect for only the remaining four months of the contract term.
- 6. The effective date of the adjustment to the contract payment is July 1, 1980.
- 7. That Exhibit "A" attached, is a proper form to provide for the amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Auditor & the Commissioner of Public Utilities are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Mr. C's Janitorial Service, Inc. to amend Contract No. 15007 in such form as is substantially in conformance with Exhibit "A".
