

ORDINANCE No. **149949**

An Ordinance authorizing the creation of fourteen (14) positions within the Fire Bureau for the period beginning July 1, 1980 and ending September 30, 1980; creating fourteen (14) Public Service Employment positions under CETA Title II-D to implement a Residential Fire Safety Program at a cost not to exceed \$19,155 and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland has been designated by the United States Department of Labor as Prime Sponsor for administering funds under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) to provide employment and training services for unemployed persons.
2. The Fire Bureau has approached the Training and Employment Division with an unsolicited request for funding of a Residential Fire Safety Program for the City of Portland, which will provide training and employment opportunities for senior adults residing in the City.
3. The Training and Employment Division recognizes the Older Worker (55 and over) as a significant segment and target group for employment and training services and recognizes the public need for Fire Safety programming.
4. The Fire Bureau presents itself to the Training and Employment Division as an appropriate worksite and training agent capable of providing employment and training services to this target group.
5. The Training and Employment Division therefore agrees to support the creation of fourteen (14) Public Service Employment positions under the Fire Bureau at a cost not to exceed \$19,155.
6. The total cost of the positions created herein will be derived from the U.S. Department of Labor CETA funds, Title II-D and is budgeted in the CETA fund through FY 80-81.
7. The positions and the City Bureau to which they are assigned are set out in Attachment "A" hereof.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That fourteen (14) CETA Title II-D positions be created in the Fire Bureau.
- b. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to charge the costs associated with the positions to RU682, in the Training and Employment Division FY 80-81 budget.
