ORDINANCE NO. 149952

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to execute and deliver to Gabriel J. Sugarman a quit claim deed releasing the City's interest in a sewer easement in connection with SW Bennington Drive and Private Property Sanitary Sewer Relocation Project and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. There is an existing 8" sewer pipe running between lots 15 and 16, Block 8, Arlington Heights, Multnomah County, Oregon.
- The said sewer was constructed by the developer of the Arlington Heights Subdivision in approximately 1911 and has been maintained since by the City.
- 3. The developer of said Arlington Heights Subdivision reserved an easement for the perpetual maintennance of said sewer, said reservation being contained in that certain deed recorded September 1, 1914 in Book 671 Page 122, and in deed recorded November 25, 1914 in Book 676 Page 129, Multnomah County deed records.
- 4. The present property owners development plans require relocation of the existing sewer. Said relocation has been completed at the property owners expense, and a sewer easement has been secured for said relocated sewer.
- 5. The existing sewer has been abandoned and the Citys' rights in said sewer should now be released.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The release of all the Citys right, title and interest in the following land is authorized:

That portion of the land reserved for sewer easement purposes in deed recorded September 1, 1914 in Book 671 Page 122, and deed recorded November 25, 1914 in Book 676, Page 129, Mult-nomah County deed records, lying adjacent to the common lot line between Lots 15 and 16, Block 8, Arlington Heights, Multnomah County, Oregon, except the westerly 22.0 feet thereof.

ORDINANCE No. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to execute and deliver to Gabriel J. Sugarman 17745 SE Stark Street Portland, Oregon 97233 a quit claim deed approved as to form by the City Attorney releasing the interest of the City in and to property heretofore described. Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the release of the sewer easement might jeopardize the owners ability to develop the property in an appropriate manner; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council. org staving bus owing notonings !
