Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- This resolution clarifies City Council's role in the COVID-19 response, linking the ECC and other Bureau efforts with City Council in a public hearing setting
- aligns City's Council's COVID-19 response with City Council's adopted values and goals in existing plans and policies;
