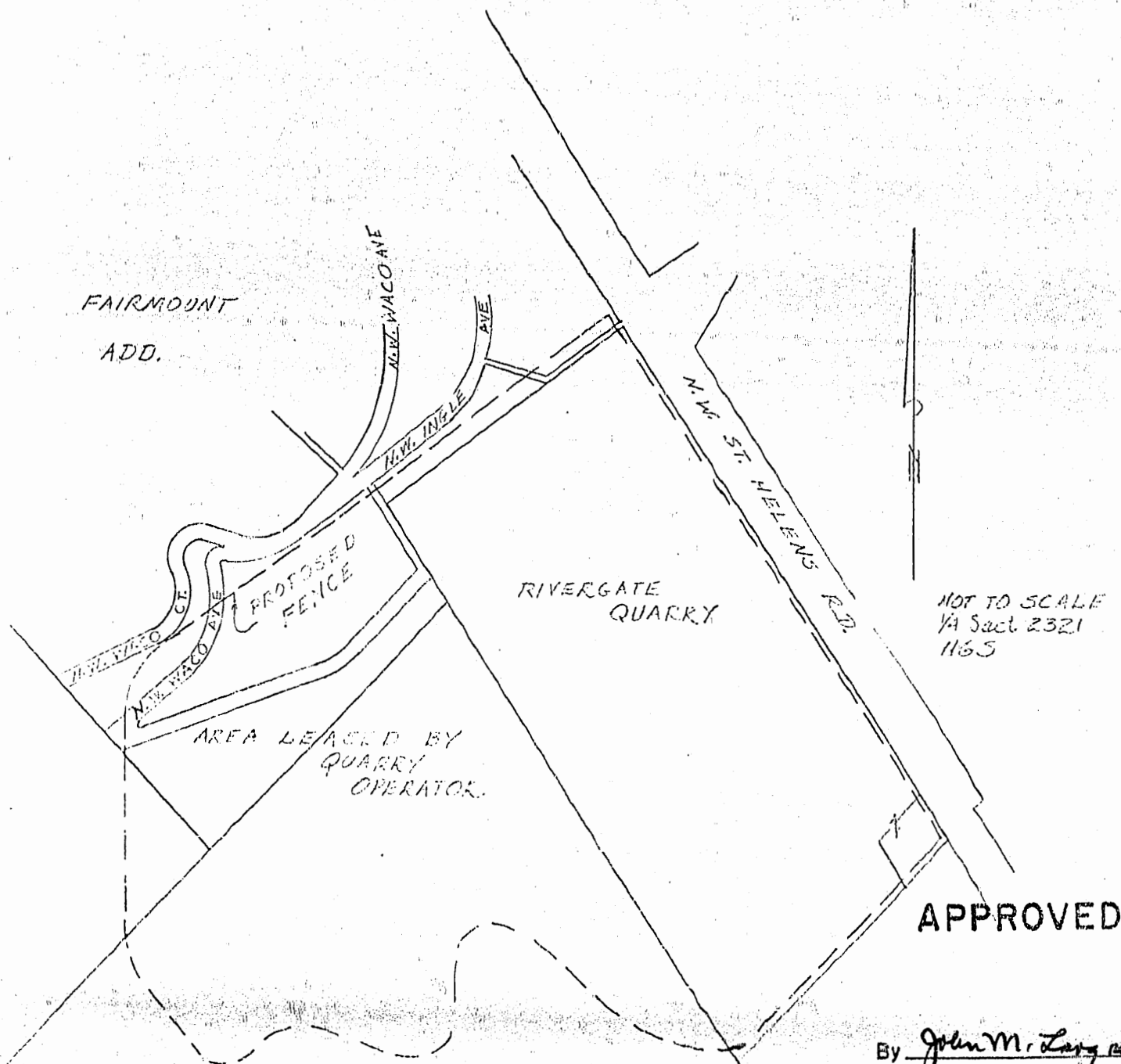

ORDINANCE NO. 149968

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the Portland Development Commission to erect and maintain a 6 foot high chain link fence topped with three strands of barbed wire at two locations across N.W. Waco Avenue southerly of N.W. Waco Court, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Development Commission has requested permission to erect and maintain a 6 foot high chain link fence topped with three strands of barbed wire at two locations across N.W. Waco Avenue southerly of N.W. Waco Court.
2. The reason for this request is that the Portland Development Commission has purchased the quarry on N.W. St. Helens Road known as the Rivergate Quarry and the quarry operators lease to adjacent land in Forest Park and it was determined in cooperation with the Bureau of Parks and Risk Management that the quarry should be fenced in order to protect the public from possible injury and the City from potential liability.
3. The proposed fence would not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is granted to Portland Development Commission, 1500 S.W. 1st Avenue, Portland 97201, permittee, to erect and maintain a 6 foot high chain link fence topped with three strands of barbed wire at two locations across N.W. Waco Avenue southerly of N.W. Waco Court as shown on the map marked "Exhibit A" attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) That the Portland Development Commission and/or the Bureau of Parks actively pursue the vacation of N.W. Waco Avenue southerly of its intersection with N.W. Waco Court.
 - (2) That the Portland Development Commission, the Bureau of Parks, and Risk Management present to the City Auditor an agreement to be filed with the original of this Ordinance which defines responsibilities relative to the maintenance of the fence authorized by this Ordinance and liability in the event there is a claim against the City by reason of this fence being in a dedicated right of way.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
