### ORDINANCE NO. 119976

An Ordinance changing the zoning for Lots 8, 9 and 10, Block 3, Bertha, from R5 to C4 located on the southeast side of Capitol Highway, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Jack L. and Gloria A. Stevens, contract purchasers of the property at 6602 SW Capitol Highway, have filed petition for a zone change from R5 to C4 in order to use the existing building as a real estate office or business office.
- 2. The legal description of said property is Lots 8, 9, and 10, Block 3, Bertha (portion on southeast side of street).
- 3. Applicant has paid the proper fee for the filing of such a petition.
- 4. A duly authorized and held public hearing has been conducted by the City's Hearings Officer on April 7, 1980 (Planning Commission File No. 6940) and the Hearings Officer recommended that the application for zone change to C4 be denied but that a Revocable Permit be allowed to use the existing building located at 6602 SW Capitol Highway as business or professional offices, under certain conditions.
- 5. On April 24, 1980, the applicants, Jack L. and Gloria A. Stevens, appealed the decision of the Hearings Officer. The appeal was forwarded to the Planning Commission, but no members requested review. Thus, the appeal went directly to the City Council for review.
- 6. On June 4, 1980, the City Council conducted a public hearing and reversed the decision of the Hearings Officer, granting the zone change from R5 to C4.
- 7. In granting the zone change, the Council found that the described parcel is the remaining part of an island formed by four streets and already zoned C4 on the south portion.
- 8. The Council also noted that surrounding property owners expressed no objection to the zone change.
- 9. The City Auditor has complied with the notice requirements of the ordinance for the hearing before the Hearings Officer and the appeal hearing before the City Council.

# ORDINANCE No.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the zone be changed from R5 to C4 on Lots 8, 9 and 10, Block 3, Bertha (portion on southeast side of Capitol Highway).

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This order shall not be effective and no change shall be made to the zoning maps until acceptance and recording as provided in Section 33.102.010 of the City Code.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because there should be no delay in the beneficial use of the above-described property; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
