Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

• The purpose of this legislation is to establish City Council support and authorization to accept \$32,250 from Oregon Department of Transportation for transportation safety programs, education, and encouragement for people walking, biking, and driving.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- Costs for this grant will be posted to grant order TR03180001 and grant TR000318.
- A 20% required match of \$7,998.95 is required and will be provided by budgeted staff in the FY2020-21 and 2021-2022 budgets of Portland Bureau of Transportation.
- No work outside the scope of this agreement is anticipated for this project.

Community impacts and community involvement:

- Funding to implement pedestrian/bike/driver safety programs, outreach and education efforts in Portland and East Multnomah County will have a positive educational impact on community members and a positive financial impact on a limited number of non-profit organizations, a limited number of design and video production businesses, and a summer intern.
- Funding will be used to pay non-profit organizations serving community members that are lower income, community members of color, immigrant and refugee community members, and community members with limited English language skills primarily in East Portland and East Multnomah County to collaborate and coordinate with Portland Bureau of Transportation on pedestrian/driver safety outreach and education events and trainings. Funding will also be used to translate materials, add close caption text to educational videos, provide in-person and/or virtual interpretation services, purchase social media ads, and support a summer intern to assist with transportation safety education and outreach.
- Portland Bureau of Transportation staff and summer intern will educate community members in English and other languages about BIKESHARE, Sunday Parkways events, optional modes of transportation, Oregon traffic laws, Portland infrastructure, and transportation safety behaviors. These efforts are designed to increase pedestrian, bike, and driver safety on Portland streets leading to a reduction of fatal and serious crashes.
