

ORDINANCE NO. 149980

An Ordinance transferring \$201,500 within the Federal Grants and General Funds; increasing appropriations in the Office of Planning and Development (AU 500) and the Bureau of Economic Development (AU 630) for a federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Vacuum Sweeping Pilot Project; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants pursuant hereto; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 149364 authorized the application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for an Air Quality Grant to evaluate the effectiveness of vacuum sweeping streets to control airborne particulates. Local match of \$67,000 was required and would be provided as in-kind services by the Bureau of Economic Development, the Bureau of Maintenance, and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality. Indirect costs were waived.
2. The United States Environmental Protection Agency awarded an Air Program Grant to the City of Portland in the amount of \$201,500, which Council accepted (Ordinance No. 149749) on June 11, 1980 after preparation of the Office's FY 80-81 budget.
3. Ordinance No. 149749 appropriated \$45,000 of the \$201,500 EPA grant for use in FY 79-80; however, these funds were not expended during the course of the fiscal year. Therefore, it is necessary to amend the Office's FY 80-81 budget by reappropriating the initial \$45,000 in grant funds, along with the \$156,500 balance of the grant, for use in FY 80-81.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants pursuant hereto.
- b. The FY 80-81 budget is hereby amended by the increase in resources and requirements in the Federal Grants and General Funds and transfer of appropriations as follows:
