

**ORDINANCE No. 149981**

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids for custodial services for the Water Services Building for the Bureau of Facilities Management, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The existing five year contract for custodial services at the Water Services Building will expire on October 1, 1980.
2. The Bureau of Facilities Management requires a new five year contract for this service.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office on July 1, 1980 and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. The Auditor and City of Portland hereby are authorized to execute a contract with the responsible bidder for the service described in Section 1 hereof in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on July 1, 1980.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1980-81 budget, General Fund, Bureau of Facilities Management, (BUC 34800294, Project 4028, Line Item 210, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.


