#### ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 15735 between American Building Maintenance, Inc. and the City of Portland by adjusting contract payments to reflect cost of living increases, providing for additional services, increasing the monthly contract payments by a total of \$1,710.02, providing for acceptance, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On October 1, 1976 the City entered into Contract No. 15735 with American Building Maintenance, Inc., to provide custodial services at Police Headquarters.
- 2. The agreement provides that the contract price may be modified as mutually agreed upon on a year to year basis.
- 3. That the Contractor's operating costs have increased and the contract sum is based upon operating costs. The basis for the contract price negotiation is the Consumer's Price Index and documented wage increase costs for the Portland area. The negotiated cost of living adjustment is 11.7%. Additional services for the facility are required with an increase of frequency of certain specified services and the addition of services not provided for in the specifications. The additional cost of these services is \$700.00 per month. Funds for the additional contract payments are contained in the 1980-81 budget of the Bureau of Facilities Management.
- 4. The effective date of the adjustment to the contract payment is July 1, 1980.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Contract No. 15735 is hereby amended by increasing the monthly payment by \$1,710.02 and by adding the following additional services.
  - Floor Maintenance: (a) Entrance Lobbies, Wet mop daily;
     (b) Increase waxing in heavy traffic areas 2 times per month.
  - Carpet Maintenance: (a) Add carpeted stairs to be shampooed
     2 times per year.
