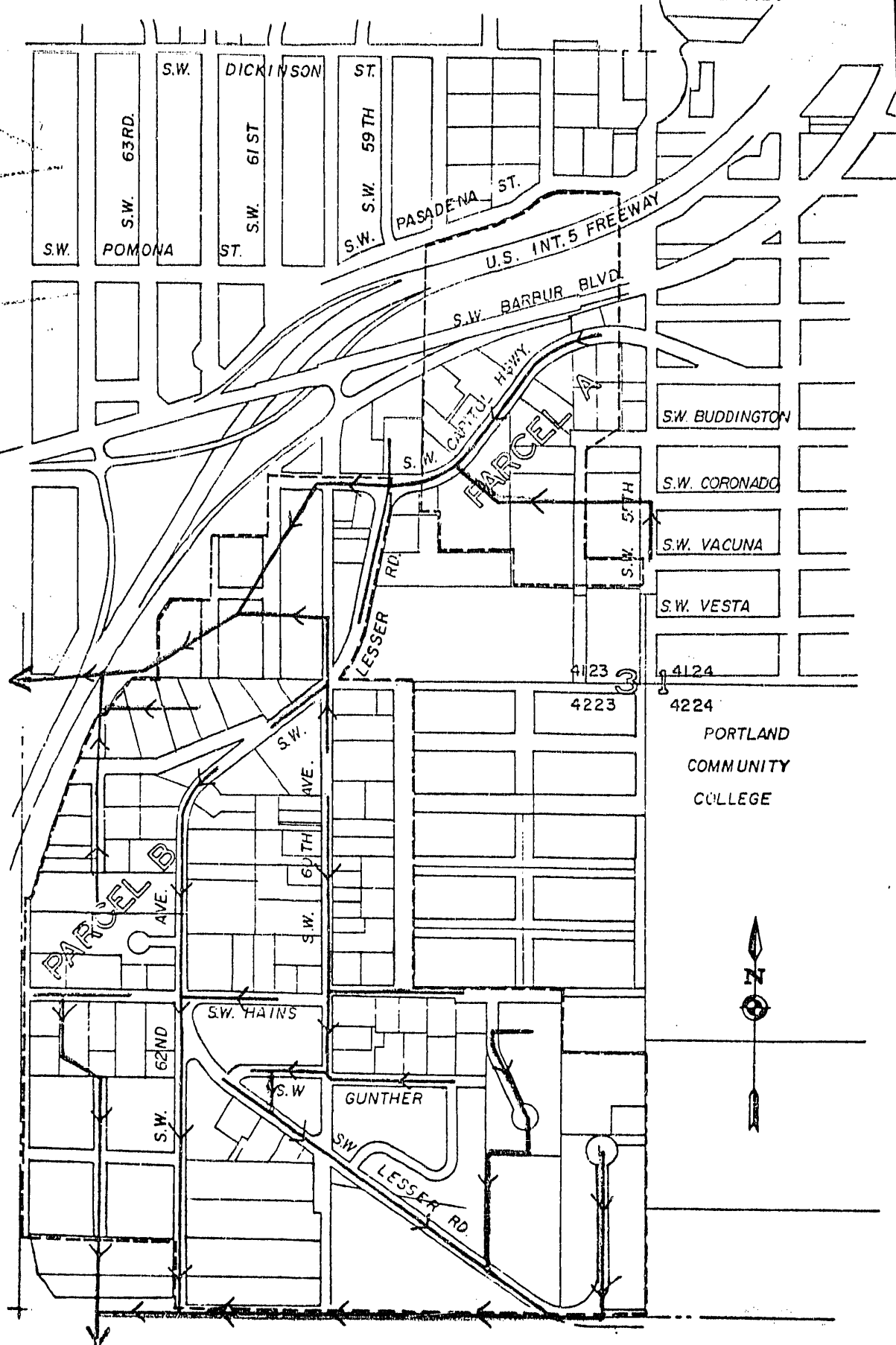

| July 16, 1981 | Final plans and specifications complete and transmitted to Auditor's Office |
| Nov. 13, 1981 | Assessment notices sent to property owners; remonstrance period begins |
| Nov. 25, 1981 | Neighborhood meeting held to inform and answer questions of property owners |
| Dec. 2, 1981 | Remonstrance period ends, public hearing held |
| Dec. 16, 1981 | Council passes time and manner ordinance |
| Dec. 29, 1981 | City sends out advertisement for bids |

ORDINANCE No. 149987

An Ordinance adopting the preliminary plans and specifications and time schedule for installation of sanitary facilities in the SW Lesser Road area, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The administrator of the Oregon State Health Division adopted findings by order dated November 1, 1979 pursuant to ORS 222.880 that a health hazard exists in the SW Lesser Road area described in the Order and filed a certified copy of said findings with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission.
2. The Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission annexed said area to the City of Portland by Boundary Commission Order No. 1520 effective December 13, 1979.
3. The State Health Division pursuant to ORS 222.897(1) directed the City of Portland by certified letter received on November 7, 1979 to cause a study to be made and preliminary plans and specifications developed for the sanitary facilities necessary to remove or alleviate the conditions causing danger to public health and also to prepare a schedule setting out the steps necessary to put the plan into operation and submit said plans, specifications, and schedule to the Environmental Quality Commission.
4. The City Engineer did develop said preliminary plans, specifications and schedule and submitted them to the Environmental Quality Commission on March 28, 1980.
5. The Environmental Quality Commission received said plans, specifications and schedule, and approved them on April 18, 1980.
6. The Council of the City of Portland did adopt Resolution No. 32669 on May 7, 1980 requiring from the City Engineer plans and specifications for the construction of the SW Lesser Road, SW Capitol Highway Sanitary Sewer System.
7. That in accordance with ORS 222.900(c) the Council of the City of Portland is required to pass an ordinance adopting said preliminary plans and specifications and time schedule as approved by the Environmental Quality Commission.

ORDINANCE No.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That in accordance with ORS 222.900(c) the preliminary plans (Exhibit "A"), time schedule (Exhibit "B"), and the City of Portland Standard Construction Specifications which were approved by the Environmental Quality Commission on April 18, 1980 be hereby adopted.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in proceeding with this project would result in unnecessarily continuing the health hazards which this sanitary sewer system will alleviate; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
