Am Ordinance establishing City M1, M3 and FF zoning in recently annexed Rivergate Industrial District and adjacent areas; the entire property being bounded by the North Portland Harbor, Railroad rightof-way on the east, the Columbia Slough and North Columbia Boulevard on the south and the Willamette River on the west, and previously zoned County M1 and F2, and declaring an emergency.


The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Rivergate Industrial District and other nearby properties have been recently annexed to the City.
- In accordance with Title 33, Planning and Zoning, of the Code of the City of Portland, said area retains the zoning regulations of the former jurisdiction, Multnomah County, until City zoning is established.
- The Recommended Comprehensive Plan, adopted by the Planning Commission on November 9, 1979, after duly authorized and conducted public hearings has recommended the adoption of the above stated city zones in said annexed area.
- On June 3, 1980, a duly authorized and conducted public hearing was held, at which time the Report and Recommendation incorporated herein and thereby made a part of this Ordinance was adopted by the Planning Commission.
- The notice requirements for public hearings have been met.
- The Zoning Code requires the initiation of City zoning on annexed property within six months of the annexation in order that all appropriate and pertinent City codes should become applicable to such property.
- There is a public need to affix these City zoning designations to the property in order to conform to the Code of the City of Portland and assure that appropriate and pertinent planning, zoning and building regulations of the City shall apply. The zoning designations are in accordance with generally accepted land use planning standards in that they reflect the uses to which much of the property has been previously been put, are consistent with the pre-existing zoning scheme of the City of Portland, and take into consideration the service capacities and land hazards of said property. (PC File No. 6911, 6945, 6947 and 6948.)

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

City zoning shall be established as indicated on the map designated as Amended Exhibit attached hereto and incorporated by reference and thereby made a part of this ordinance.

- b. This zone change is granted under the following conditions:
 - 1. The Port of Portland and other property owners shall work with the Transportation Planning section of the Bureau of Planning of the City of Portland and Tri-Met to develop a transit incentive and rideshare plan for the Rivergate Industrial area.
 - 2. The Port of Portland shall designate for open space a 150' wide buffer strip along the north bank of the Columbia Slough as part of a subdivision plat for development for the 40 Mile Loop or Corps of Engineers Plan I Flood Control Project when funds become available. It is understood that road and utilities will be extended across the Columbia Slough in Rivergate through the open space area as shown on the subdivision plat.
