ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 17380 (as amended) between the City of Portland and the Portland Development Commission to extend the contract through September 30, 1980 for the Innovative Grant Program, pursuant to Section 3 of the Agreement; retroactive to May 3, 1980; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On August 3, 1978 (Ordinance No. 146247), Council accepted a \$600,000 Innovative Grant from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
2. Ordinance No. 146247 also authorized a contract (No. 17380) between the City of Portland, Office of Planning and Development, and the Portland Development Commission for Innovative Grant program development and execution, initially due to expire on November 15, 1979 but subsequently extended to May 3, 1980 by Ordinance No. 148773.
3. The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has granted approval of a "no cost" time extension for the Innovative Grant through September 30, 1980 to allow for expenditure of revolving account funds past the May 3, 1980 extension.
4. Therefore, it is now appropriate and necessary to retroactively extend Contract No. 17380 (as amended) between the City of Portland and the Portland Development Commission for the Innovative Grant through September 30, 1980.
5. In accordance with the previously granted HUD extension, the City may expend Innovative Grant funds after September 30, 1980; however, no new costs may be incurred beyond September 30, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Contract No. 17380, Section 3, between the City of Portland, Office of Planning and Development, and the Portland Development Commission is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

3. TIME OF PERFORMANCE

The Commission shall commence the services provided under this Agreement as of the date of execution and such services shall continue through September 30, 1980 unless extended by written agreement of both parties hereto.

b. It is the understanding of both the City of Portland and the Portland Development Commission that the amendment referred to herein is retroactive to May 3, 1980 and all other terms and conditions of Contract No. 13780 (as amended) remain intact; and that the City may expend Innovative Grant funds after September 30, 1980; however, no new costs may be incurred on the Innovative Grant Program beyond September 30, 1980.

Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the contractee (PDC) has filed with the City Auditor a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof which has been approved by the City Attorney.

Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there should be no interruption in the Innovative Grant Program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage by the Council.
