The parties have previously executed a contract providing for the training of CETA participants, which contract is known as Contract No. 18295. That contract should now be amended to increase fringe benefit amounts by \$640, from \$267 to \$907, retroactive, to allow for agency expenditures.

The parties to the contract therefore agree:

1. That line item 170, Fringe Benefits is increased from \$267 to \$907, an increase of \$640, retroactive, to allow for agency expenditures and resulting reimbursement.

This agreement entered into between the City of Portland, Oregon and Northwest  
Repertory Dance Company, Contractor.

The parties have previously executed a contract providing for the training of CETA participants,  
which contract is known as Contract No. 18330. That contract should now be amended to  
increase salary amounts by \$468, from \$21,318 to \$21,786 retroactive  
to January 1, 1980, allowing for costs incurred through September 30, 1980.

The parties to the contract therefore agree:

1. That line item 110, Full Time Employees is increased by \$468,  
from \$21,318 to \$21,786, retroactive to January 1, 1980 allowing  
for increases due to changes in the Federal minimum wage.

ORDINANCE No. **150019**

An Ordinance authorizing amendments to Contract No. 18303, Contract No. 18295, Contract No. 18330 under the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division; increasing wage and fringe benefit amounts; increasing contract amounts by \$1,598; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland has been designated by the United States Department of Labor as Prime Sponsor for administering funds under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) to provide employment and training services for unemployed persons.
2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148560, Council authorized contracts with Storefront Actor's Theatre, Northwest Outward Bound School and Northwest Repertory Dance Company to provide work-sites under CETA Title II-D for unemployed persons.
3. Each contractor now finds it necessary to request contract amendments which will increase wage and fringe benefit amounts.
4. Contract No. 18303, Storefront Actor's Theatre seeks an increase of \$490 within line item 170, increasing that amount to \$1,064.
5. Contract No. 18395, Northwest Outward Bound School seeks an increase of \$640 within line item 170, increasing that amount to \$907.
6. Contract No. 18330, Northwest Repertory Dance Company seeks an increase of \$468 within line item 110, increasing that amount to \$21,786.
7. Funds are available to support these amendments under Title II-D of CETA from the Department of Labor and is budgeted in the CETA fund through FY 80-81.
8. It is therefore appropriate that the Commissioner of Public Utilities and City Auditor execute on behalf of the City, the amendments to Contract No.'s 18303, 18395, 18330 hereof.

# ORDINANCE No.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and City Auditor execute on behalf of the City the amendments to contract No.'s 18303, 18295, 18330 set out in exhibits hereof.
- b. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to charge the costs associated with this action to RU 682 in the Training and Employment Division FY 80-81 budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will cause unnecessary program interruption and administrative delay in the function of the Human Resources Bureau; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
