

ORDINANCE NO. 150020

An Ordinance authorizing a Contract with Marshall Associated Contractors, Inc., for the construction of a 16-inch water main in N. Willamette Boulevard extending down Mock's Bluff to N. Basin Avenue for the Bureau of Water Works in the amount of \$46,468.35, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. It is to the City's advantage to construct a 16-inch water main in N. Willamette Blvd. extending down Mock's Bluff to N. Basin Avenue. This will eliminate the dependence upon a single 16-inch supply main in N. Basin Avenue, which presently services the entire area of Swan Island, and will provide uninterrupted water service for future development in Mock's Bottom.
2. Federal funds are available for 80% of the cost of this project through the Economic Development Administration. The Port of Portland will provide the remaining 20% local share of costs.
3. Marshall Associated Contractors, Inc. was the lowest responsive bidder for the contract portion of the project.
4. Award of Contract to said bidder for accomplishing said work has been recommended and approved by the Commissioner-in-Charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the responsive bidder for the project described in Section 1 hereof in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on May 16, 1980, in the estimated amount of \$46,468.35.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a warrant chargeable to the 1980-81 Budget; Bureau of Water Works, Water Fund, Object Code 630, Project 3412, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
