

AGREEMENT AMENDING CONTRACT NO. 18200

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into between the CITY OF PORTLAND, OREGON, and the COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH, contractor.

The parties have previously entered into a contract delegating the management responsibilities of the Area Agency on Aging for Portland/Multnomah County to the City for the period of July 1, 1979, through June 30, 1980, which contract is known as Contract No. 18200. The contract shall now be amended by extending the period from June 30, 1980, through June 30, 1981, to allow time to resolve the question of management transfer of the Area Agency on Aging from the City to the County.

The parties, therefore, agree that Contract No. 18200 is amended as follows:

The contract is amended by changing the termination date from June 30, 1980, to June 30, 1981.

This change shall be incorporated into Contract No. 18200 upon receipt of the appropriate signatures.

The parties witness their consent to be bound by the terms of this amendment to the contract by signing below.

ORDINANCE NO. **150035**

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 18200 between the City of Portland and Multnomah County by extending the period through June 30, 1981, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Resolution No. 31412, the City assumed management responsibility of the Area Agency on Aging for Portland/Multnomah County Planning and Services Area for the period July 1, 1974, through June 30, 1979.
2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148363, approved by Council August 29, 1979, Contract No. 18200 was authorized with the County for the City to continue the management responsibility of the Area Agency on Aging for the period July 1, 1979, through June 30, 1980.
3. Pursuant to a report submitted by the County Task Force on Aging, chaired by Commissioner Gladys McCoy, a recommendation was presented to transfer the management of the Area Agency on Aging to the County.
4. Since that report has not been accepted by either the City Council or the County Commission to date, it is necessary to continue the FY 1979-1980 contract until the question of transfer has been resolved.
5. It is therefore appropriate that the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor accept, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contract No. 18200 with Multnomah County to allow time for the question of transfer to be resolved by extending the period from June 30, 1980, to June 30, 1981, similar in form to Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contract No. 18200 to allow time to resolve the question of the Area Agency on Aging management transfer by

extending the period from June 30, 1980, to June 30, 1981, similar in form to Exhibit "A".

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because any delay in the enactment of this Ordinance may interrupt the continuation of services to the elderly; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
