

## ORDINANCE NO. 150056

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the National Endowment for the Arts for a Comprehensive Technical Assistance grant to provide training opportunities for the Metropolitan Arts Commission and staff, authorizing a contract, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the City of Portland and Multnomah County have established the Metropolitan Arts Commission in order to promote and encourage public awareness of, and interest in, the performing and visual arts.
2. The National Endowment for the Arts has established a Comprehensive Technical Assistance grant to assist in development of technical expertise in program development and fund raising.
3. The Comprehensive Technical Assistance grant will increase the Commission's effectiveness in achieving the Metropolitan Arts Commission's stated goals and objectives.
4. No matching funds are required for the Comprehensive Technical Assistance grant.
5. The grant will consist of technical assistance from the National Endowment for the Arts staff to the Metropolitan Arts Commission and involves no funds or expense to the City

ORDINANCE No.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner in charge shall make application to the National Endowment for the Arts for a Comprehensive Technical Assistance grant.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt and accounting for the grant project.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the regulations governing the grant applications require immediate application, and delay in application may result in the loss of the opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
