ORDINANCE No. 150061

An Ordinance establishing rates of pay for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1980 for Recreation Instructors represented by Municipal Employees Local #483, authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw salary warrants at these rates, authorizing employer payment of the employee contribution to PERS for these employees and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the City and Municipal Employees, Local #483, have negotiated a labor agreement for the period July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1982 affecting the terms and conditions of employment for City Recreation Instructors.
- 2. That the contract provides for changes in rates of salary for the period July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981 and for employer payment of the employee contribution to PERS (Public Employes Retirement System) as contemplated in Resolution #32695.
- 3. Salary rates for classifications listed in Exhibit A attached to the original only of this Ordinance should be established effective July 1, 1980.
- 4. The Mayor and the Auditor should be authorized to draw salary warrants at these rates.
- 5. Benefit rates for classifications listed in Exhibit A should be set so that the employee contribution to PERS is paid by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The rates of pay for Recreation Instructor classifications listed in Exhibit A, attached to the original only of this Ordinance, are hereby established effective July 1, 1980.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw salary warrants at these rates.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because prompt action is necessary for the orderly implementation of new pay rates; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
