

ORDINANCE NO. 150093

An Ordinance amending Chapter 3.02, Council Organization and Procedure, of the Code of the City of Portland, by adding a new Section 3.02.036 to provide procedures for a Consent Agenda, and declaring an emergency;

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the voters of the City of Portland at the election held May 20, 1980 amended the Charter of the City of Portland by adding a new Section 2-127 to provide that the City Council by rule may establish a procedure for a Consent Agenda for items of Council business;
- 2. That the Code of the City of Portland should be amended by adding a new Section 3.02.036 to provide for such Consent Agenda procedures;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Chapter 3.02, Council Organization and Procedure, of the Code of the City of Portland is hereby amended by adding a new Section 3.02.036 to read as follows:

3.02.036 Consent Agenda. (a) Any council member, the city auditor or any appointed officer filing an ordinance, resolution, report or other item with the city auditor for city council consideration shall clearly designate such items as "Consent" or "Regular" calendar.

(b) The consent agenda may include emergency ordinances, non-emergency ordinances, resolutions, reports or any other matter for council consideration except:

- (1) Zoning matters,
- (2) Any matter which will increase an appropriation unit's budget,
- (3) Any matter requested to be placed on the regular agenda at the time of filing with the auditor.

(c) Both the draft and final council calendar shall clearly distinguish consent from regular calendar items. The auditor shall give consecutive council calendar numbers to all items filed for the consent agenda. The consent agenda shall be clearly designated. The consent agenda shall be positioned

in the council calendar in accordance with Rule IV of Rules for Council business contained in Section 3.02.040 of the City Code.

(d) Any item filed for the consent agenda may be removed from the consent agenda by a member of the city council, a member of the staff of any member of the city council, or any individual by verbal or written request made to the city auditor prior to the council meeting or verbal request at any time prior to council vote on the consent agenda. When so removed the item shall be considered individually at the end of the regular calendar at the same council meeting.

(e) At any meeting at which there is a consent agenda on the calendar, the ayes and nays shall be taken upon the passage of all items on the consent agenda by a single council vote. It shall not be necessary that there be a reading or readings of the titles or the effect of the items on a consent agenda or that time elapse between the introduction and final passage of the items. Items on a consent agenda shall not be subject to amendment or debate. The unanimous vote of all members of the council present and of not less than four (4) members, shall be required to pass a consent agenda.

Section 2. The Council declares:

In order that the procedures for a City Council Consent Agenda may be adopted and such procedures made effective at the earliest possible time, therefore, an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
