

ORDINANCE NO. 150094

An Ordinance amending Rule IV of Section 3.02.040 of the Code of the City of Portland to make provision for procedures for a Consent Agenda and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the voters of the City of Portland at the election held May 20, 1980, amended the Charter of the City of Portland by adding a new Section 2-127 to provide that the City Council may by rule establish a procedure for a Consent Agenda for items of Council business.
2. That the Code of the City of Portland has been amended by adding a new Section 3.02.036 to provide for such Consent Agenda procedures and the Code should further be amended by amending Rule IV of Section 3.02.040, Rules for Council Business, to provide for the Consent Agenda in the regular order of Council business.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Rule IV OF Section 3.02.040 of the Code of the City of Portland is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.02.040 Rules for Council business. The following rules shall be used for conducting Council business:

Rule IV. The business of the Council shall be presented in the following order:

 - (6) Consent agenda. The consent agenda may include any items of business regardless of when such items would otherwise be considered if not appearing on the consent agenda. The order of listing items on the consent agenda shall be the same as items on the regular agenda.

 - (8) Renumber . . Same as prior (7)
 - (9) Renumber . . Same as prior (8)
 - (10) Renumber . . Same as prior (9)
