

ORDINANCE No. 150100

An Ordinance authorizing donation of a golf pass good for one year to the Oregon Open Heart Golf Tournament, August 23 and 24, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Open Heart Golf Tournament organizers have requested donation of a golf pass good for free play for one year on any city-owned golf course as a prize for their tournament.
2. The donation of such a golf pass for this tournament has been recommended by the Superintendent of Parks and approved by the Commissioner in Charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Donation of a golf pass good for one year hereby is authorized to the Oregon Open Heart Golf Tournament to be held on August 23 and 24, 1980, at the Tualatin Country Club.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in enactment of this ordinance would cause unnecessary hardship in making arrangements for the Oregon Open Heart Golf Tournament; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
