Appoint and reappoint members to the Citizen Review Committee, an advisory board to the City Auditor's Independent Police Review and the Police Bureau's Internal Affairs (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance 175652, June 6, 2001, establishing the Citizen Review Committee;

WHEREAS, a Selection Committee consisting of four Citizen Review Committee representatives, two members of the community, and five staff members from Independent Police Review reviewed 29 applications. A panel of one Citizen Review Committee member and two Independent Police Review staff members interviewed 15 candidates. They recommended 17 to the City Auditor for nomination for Council appointment;
