### ORDINANCE No. 190357

\*Create a new non-represented classification of Mental Health Crisis Clinician I and establish a compensation range for this classification (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating a new non-represented classification and establishing a compensation rate, effective 4/14/2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

A. The following classification is being created:
