Accept proposal of Raimore Construction, LLC for the Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project for \$7,530,290 (Procurement Report - RFP No. 00001521)

April 21, 2021

TO THE COUNCIL:

The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is responsible for transportation operations and improvements within the City's public right-of-way. The Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project will construct safety improvements on SE Division Street between SE 80th and SE 174th Avenues.

The goal of the Project is to construct multi-modal safety improvements along SE Division Street between SE 80th and SE 174th Avenues (approximately 5 miles). The project includes ten new signalized crossings, pedestrian-scaled street lighting, raised center medians, protected bike lanes, civil improvements including concrete sidewalk and ADAramps, signing, striping and tree planting.

Ordinance No. 190042 was approved by City Council on July 8, 2020 authorizing Procurement Services to use an alternative contracting method to select a proposer for the Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project. The Chief Procurement Officer advertised Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 00001521 on January 6, 2021, for the construction of the Outer Division Multi-Modal Safety Project with an overall budget of \$11,300,000. PBOT rated the project estimate confidence level as Low at that time. On February 18, 2021 five (5) proposals were received. The proposals were reviewed, evaluated, and scored by a seven (7)member evaluation committee. The evaluation committee Introduced by Mayor Ted Wheeler

Date Filed with Clerk April 13, 2021 consisted of representatives from PBOT and two (2) members from the Minority Evaluator Program. The evaluation committee selected Raimore Construction, LLC as the highest scoring proposer. Based on the proposal received, PBOT anticipates the construction contract cost to not exceed \$7,530,290.

The City's equity in contracting aspirational goal of 20% of the hard construction costs for subcontractor and supplier utilization of firms certified by the State's Certification Office for Business Inclusion and Diversity (COBID) applies to this project. **Raimore Construction, LLC has committed to subcontract 29.63% to COBID Certified firms** as follows:

Raimore Construction, LLC acting as the prime contractor intends to self-perform 70.37% of the work and to contract 0% to non-certified firms.

Raimore Construction, LLC is located in Portland, Oregon, and is a State COBID Certified DBE/MBE Contractor and is an African American/male owned firm. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and are in full compliance with all of the City's contracting requirements. PBOT has funds budgeted in PBOT Capital Project T00629, which is included in FY 20-21 budget and five-year CIP forecast.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two(2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20t% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.

Procurement Services recommends that Council accept this Report and authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute the contract with Raimore Construction, LLC.
