1. Council passed Ordinance No. 182216, authorizing the execution of a contract for the Portland Police Data System Records Management System Replacement Project, also known as the Regional Justice Information Network (RegJIN). The City of Portland executed Contract Number 30003029 with Versaterm, Inc. on May 17, 2013, following the successful completion of the competitive procurement process. RegJIN is used by PPB and other regional partner agencies to receive and share police information.
2. Council passed Ordinance No. 187877, authorizing the execution of Contract Number 30005161 for an Application Software Support Agreement (maintenance of the RegJIN System) which replaced Contract 30003029, effective July 14, 2016.
3. Versaterm, Inc. continues to provide PPB with application software support for RegJIN.
4. Contract Number 30005161, for the Portland Police RegJIN system, will need to increase its not-to-exceed value to \$4,340,000 in order to facilitate the continuing application's software support to July 13, 2022.
5. The necessary funding for this extension will come from existing Police Bureau General Fund resources.

6. Procurement authority for this maintenance contract amendment is through Special Procurement in accordance with City Code 5.33.D.12.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- A. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to amend an agreement with Versaterm, Inc. as outlined in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- B. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of the Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.
