ORDINANCE No. 190368

Authorize a competitive solicitation and price agreements for the urgent repair of sewer and stormwater systems for an estimated annual amount of \$2,200,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to have the ability to respond to and repair, stabilize, remediate, and construct urgent sewer and stormwater situations in the City of Portland.
- 2. These situations occur without warning and often the construction response cannot wait for, or qualify for, an Emergency Ordinance and requires services and qualified expertise that the City does not have in-house.
- 3. BES requires the assistance of contractors to dispatch on short notice in order to achieve this and maintain the health and safety of the City.
- 4. The cumulative annual cost is \$2,200,000 per fiscal year for up to a five-year period. The level of confidence is High. Funds are available in the Maintenance and Operations budget, Bureau of Environmental Services Cost Center ESWW000003 for each of these fiscal years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code Chapter 5.34 in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive offers for the urgent repair of sewer and stormwater systems.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute multiple price agreements, provided they have been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the price agreements from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
