### AGREEMENT

THIS CONTRACT, entered into between the MARQUAM MEDICAL CENTER (MMC) 2220 S.W. First Ave. Portland, Oregon 97201, a Partnership formed under the laws of the State of Oregon, hereinafter referred to as the "M.M.C." and the CITY OF PORTLAND, a municipal corporation of Oregon, hereinafter referred to as the "City,"

### WITNESSETH:

The parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The M.M.C. agrees to give physical examinations as directed by the City, to employees and prospective employees sent to the M.M.C. by the City. The physical examinations will relate to the occupational ability (see Attachment "B") and general health of the person examined and will equal or exceed the attached descriptions, Attachment "A", which forms a part of this agreement. The agrees to schedule examinations within two working days of notification. Results of each examination will be delivered by the M.M.C. In a sealed envelope with a pass or fail recommendation of the examining physician to the Civil Service Board of the City within twenty-four (24) hours after the examination is completed, Sundays and holidays excluded.
- 2. The City agrees to pay the M.M.C. for each specified examination in accordance with Attachment "A". Other requested services will be paid at the usual and customary schedule of the M.M.G.
- 3. The M.M.C. agrees to work with the City to develop additional examinations as required from time to time.
- 4. The M.M.C. agrees to hold the City, its officers and employees free and harmless and agrees to indemnify the City for any and all claims for injury to or death of persons or injury to property which may be occasioned by any services provided by the M.M.C. under the terms of this contract. At all times, while this contract is in effect, the M.M.C. agrees to maintain general liability and malpractice insurance coverage with maximum limits not less than the limits of its general liability and malpractice insurance coverage in effect at the time this contract is executed.

The M.M.C. further agrees that the insurance shall not terminate or be cancelled before completion of this contract without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the City Auditor.

- 5. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, the agrees to comply with all statutory, charter, and ordinance provisions applicable to this contract, including laws governing fair employment practices.
- 6. This contract shall be in effect from August 1, 1980 and be in force and effect until July 31, 1981, subject to extension by mutual agreement of the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this seventeenth day of July, 1980, the Marquam Medical Cente has caused this contract to be executed in triplicate by one of its partners and the City has caused the same to be executed in triplicate by its Mayor and Auditor pursuant to Ordinance No.

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# ORDINANCE No. 150109

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to execute a contract between the City of Portland and the Marquam Medical Center to perform pre-employment physicals of City employees, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Proposals have been received and evaluated by the Bureau of Personnel Services Evaluation Committee for the provision of pre-employment physicals for the term August 1, 1980 through July 31, 1981.
- 2. The proposal submitted by Marquam Medical Center was found overall to be most cost effective for the services desired.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract between the City and Marquam Medical Center from August 1, 1980 through July 31, 1981, said contract to conform to the form of the contract attached to the original only of this Ordinance, marked Exhibit "A", and by this reference made a part hereof.
- The contract shall be charged to the General Fund, Bureau of Personnel Services, Civil Service Board, Professional Services 210, Buc 31300045.
- c. The Council further directs that this contract shall take effect upon acceptance of its terms in writing by Marquam Medical Center and approved by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because continued provision of physical examination services is necessary so that there may be no interruption or delay in the personnel program of the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage by the Council.
