

ORDINANCE No. 150155

An Ordinance amending the Compensation Plan by establishing a rate of pay for the class of Seasonal Maintenance Worker and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That it would be economically advantageous to employ seasonal labor at a competitive rate that would allow the City to attract a competent seasonal work force.
2. That the City is currently employing seasonal labor for short periods of time and that the pay level now in effect may not be appropriate due to current economic conditions.
3. That there is an adequate supply of qualified applicants for short term maintenance assignments.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The class of Seasonal Maintenance Worker (1205) will be used in lieu of Seasonal Laborer effective with the passage of this Ordinance at a rate of \$4.10 per hour.
- b. Persons currently employed as Seasonal Laborers at the rate of \$5.48 will continue at that rate for the term of their current employment, but in no event beyond November 1, 1980.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the changes described in Section 1 above should be accomplished without unnecessary delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
