

ORDINANCE NO.

**150160**

An Ordinance transferring appropriations within the operating budget of the Bureau of Police, Juvenile Division, abolishing two positions of Police Sergeant and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the Bureau of Police is reorganizing its Juvenile Division to provide for a Community Juvenile Officer (C.J.O.) program and is converting it to a single, day relief operation working Monday through Friday.
2. That the overall purpose of the C.J.O. program is to develop a more favorable rapport between the juveniles and the Police that can reduce anti-social behavior and thereby improve the liveability of the City.
3. That this program will provide a Police - School liaison while continuing all juvenile investigations and some daytime specialized patrol.
4. That the C.J.O. program divides the City into twelve (12) basic High School areas with a C.J.O. assigned to each of the 12 areas.
5. That the C.J.O. will work directly in the schools making presentations on topics of Traffic Safety, Alcohol and Drugs/Narcotics Abuse, and Civics pertaining to local government operations and agencies, such as the Bureau of Police.
6. That the conversion of the Juvenile Division to a single, day relief operation will allow the abolishment of two Police Sergeant positions to provide the necessary appropriations for the necessities of the C.J.O. program.
7. That it is, therefore, necessary to transfer the needed appropriations within the Police Bureau's FY 80-81 operating budget and to abolish two positions of Police Sergeant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That two (2) positions of Police Sergeant (5134) are hereby abolished and that appropriations be transferred within the FY 80-81 operating budget of the Bureau of Police, Juvenile Division, as follows:
