ORDINANCE NO.

150164

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, in various amounts, in settlement of eight claims which have been investigated by the Committee on Claims and approved by the City Council, providing for release, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That H. Marie Sebolt, Christine Hawkins, Alpine Realty, Alvin K. Prather, Police Officer John Kraus, Police Officer Gregory C. Pluchos, Police Officer James Mooney and Police Officer John Bocciolatt have made claims against the city, which claims have been investigated by the Committee on Claims.
2. That the Committee on Claims, by report to the City Council dated July 16, 1980, has recommended settlement of these claims.
3. That the City Council, on July 23, 1980, Council Calendar No. 2628 directed that the claims be settled.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:
