ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, in various amounts, in settlement of three claims which have been investigated by the Committee on Claims and approved by the City Council, providing for release, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That Edna H. Miller, Donald D. Gerber and Delene J. Green have made claims against the city, which claims have been investigated by the Committee on Claims.
2. That the Committee on Claims, by report to the City Council dated July 16, 1980, has recommended settlement of these claims.
3. That the City Council, on July 23, 1980, Council Calendar Nos. 2629, 2630, and 2631 adopted said reports and directed that the claims be settled.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants to the claimants and in the amounts as shown below, said warrants to be drawn and charged to General Fund, Indemnities, BUC 43613472, Expense 490.

b. Delivery of the warrants authorized above shall be conditioned upon the execution and filing with the City Auditor of releases signed by the claimant and spouse, if any; said releases to be in form approved by the City Attorney and in full and complete satisfaction of any and all claims against the City of Portland, its officers, agents and employees arising out of or in connection with the claims mentioned in Section 1 hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there should be no unnecessary delay in meeting the financial obligations of the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
