

ORDINANCE No. 150166

An Ordinance authorizing compensation of the temporary City Energy Advisor, Jeanne McCormick, at the ~~after two-years rate~~ effective July 1, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That the City Energy Conservation Policy is in transition from a period of policy planning and development to one of implementation, and that this new phase requires an individual with strong managerial capabilities.
2. That the temporary City Energy Advisor, Jeanne McCormick, possesses these skills, having served the City for more than eight years in such positions as Director of the Crime Prevention Bureau, Director of Solid Waste Management, and Public Information Officer for the Department of Public Works.
3. That the shift in Ms. McCormick's duties from Administrative Assistant II in the Energy Office to City Energy Advisor involves a significant amount of additional work and responsibility.
4. That the customary three percent increase does not adequately compensate Ms. McCormick for the experience she applies to these responsibilities.
5. And that the approved 1980-81 budget for the Energy Office includes funding for the Energy Advisor position at the maximum rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the City Energy Advisor, Jeanne McCormick, be compensated at ~~the after two-years rate~~ effective July 1, 1980, and authorizes subsequent pay increases in accordance with the City's approved compensation plan.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because Ms. McCormick assumed her present responsibilities on June 30, 1980 and should be appropriately compensated without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
