

ORDINANCE No. 150177

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the Federal Aviation Administration for a grant estimated at \$27,000 in aid of the Downtown Portland Public Use Heliport Feasibility Study.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Federal Aviation Administration makes grants to local governments in aid of airport and heliport planning.
2. The Bureau of Facilities Management provides facilities planning and design, and could further the City's effort therein by a grant in aid of said services.
3. The project cost is estimated at \$30,000, of which \$3,000 is required as local share, which local share is available through in-kind services provided by existing City staff.
4. Should the City receive the grant, it will be obligated to comply with the regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration, but will not be obligated to implement any findings or recommendations generated by the study.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities shall make application to the Federal Aviation Administration for a grant of \$27,000 in aid of the Downtown Portland Public Use Heliport Feasibility Study.
- b. The Commissioner of Public Utilities is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the Federal Aviation Administration.
- c. The Commissioner of Public Utilities is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure, and accounting for the grant project.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because regulations governing the grant application require immediate application, and delay in application may result in the loss of opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
