

AGREEMENT

PARTIES:

Oregon State Department of Fish and Wildlife, 506 S.W. Mill Street,
Portland, Oregon 97204 (Fish and Wildlife)

City of Portland, Oregon, 1220 S.W. Fifth Avenue, Portland, Oregon
97204 (City)

RECITALS:

The City of Portland constructed and operates a boat launching ramp
at Willamette Park.

This ramp serves recreational boaters including sportsmen who fish
the Willamette River.

This ramp needs repairs costing an estimated \$111,923. The Oregon
State Marine Board has offered a grant of \$15,000 to the city.

This agreement specifies the division of responsibilities between
the City and Fish and Wildlife in applying for and implementing a
cooperative grant to repair the boat ramp.

AGREED:

The City and Fish and Wildlife shall seek a grant in the amount of
\$47,500 in Land and Water Conservation Funds from the Oregon State
Division of Parks and Recreation.

The City shall provide \$32,500 which added to \$15,000 provided by
the Oregon State Marine Board will serve as the required match.

The City shall provide any monetary resources above the \$95,000
specified above which the project requires.

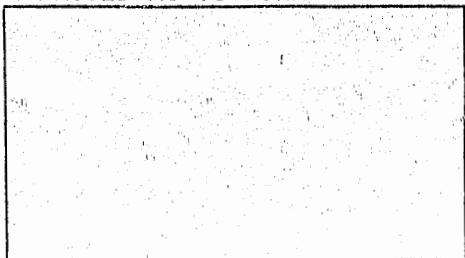
The City shall design, bid, contract and supervise the construction
of the repairs.

Fish and Wildlife shall cooperate with the City in obtaining
reimbursement from State Parks for expenditures under the grant.

The City shall maintain and operate the ramp after repairs are
completed.

ORDINANCE NO. 150179

An Ordinance authorizing the Park Bureau to make application for a grant in the amount of \$47,500 in Land & Water Conservation funds from the State of Oregon through the State Parks Division for a joint project with Oregon Fish & Wildlife Commission for repairs to Willamette Park Boat Ramp; authorizing a cooperative agreement with the Oregon Fish & Wildlife Commission for implementation of the Grant; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The currents of the Willamette River and heavy use have caused the foot of the Willamette Park Boatramp to deteriorate. For the safety of the boating public, the ramp should be repaired. An expeditious time for repairs would be during the low water season which generally occurs in September.
- 2. By Ordinance #149924 Council authorized the Park Bureau to seek funds from the State Marine Board. However, the State Marine Board has offered only another \$5,000 in addition to the \$10,000 previously committed to the estimated \$111,923 project.
- 3. The Oregon Fish & Wildlife Commission has offered to co-sponsor the project. This would allow the city to apply for \$47,500 in Land & Water Conservation funds from the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service administered by Oregon State Parks.
- 4. The City would be required to provide local match of \$32,500 to complement the \$15,000 provided by the Oregon State Marine Board. The Park Bureau would require another \$16,932 for which no grant source is available.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Auditor and Commissioner in Charge shall make application to Oregon State Parks for a grant of \$47,500 for repair of Willamette Park Boat Ramp, which grant will be co-sponsored by the Oregon State Fish and Wildlife Commission.
- b. Should the grant be approved, a contract or agreement accepting the grant is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the State and HCRS.
- d. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure and accounting for the grant project.
