

ORDINANCE NO. 150196

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION for a grant estimated at \$13,750.00 in aid of TRAFFIC SAFETY PEDESTRIAN SAFETY CAMPAIGN; authorizing contract(s) and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION makes grants to local governments in aid of EDUCATING AND INFORMING THE PUBLIC.
- 2. THE PORTLAND TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION provides TRAFFIC SAFETY INFORMATION AND EDUCATION SERVICES and could further the City's effort therein by a grant in aid of said services.
- 3. The project cost is estimated at \$13,750.00 of which \$2,750.00 is required as a local share, which local share is available to the PORTLAND TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION from SALARIES AND WAGES.
- 4. Should the City receive the grant, it will be obligated to comply with the regulations of the OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Mayor Connie McCready shall make application to OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION for a grant of \$13,750.00 in aid of PEDESTRIAN SAFETY CAMPAIGN.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. Connie McCready, Mayor, is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION.
- d. Mayor Connie McCready is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure and accounting for the grant project.
- e. Expenditures under this grant are not authorized until OREGON TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION has approved the grant; the Council has specifically appropriated the funds; and the system of accountability has been established by the Bureau of Financial Affairs.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because regulations governing the grant application require immediate application, and delay in application may result in the loss of opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
