ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance increasing resources and requirements in the Federal Grants and General Funds in the amount of \$1,202, for the purpose of appropriating grant funds to the Bureau of Economic Development for the continuation of programs under an Economic Development Administration technical assistance grant award to the City of Portland; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 147598, the City of Portland authorized acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$60,250 from the U.S. Economic Development Administration for CEDS coordination activities.
2. Of the total grant award of \$60,250, expenditures during FY 1979-80 totalled \$55,188, leaving a balance of \$1,202, as shown below:

b. Indirect costs	(3,860)
c. Total expenditures, FY 1979-80	(55,188)
d. Balance of grant award available	1,202
e. Appropriated in FY 1980-81 budget	0

3. It was not possible to estimate the amount of the grant award available at the end of FY 1979-80 during the FY 1980-81 budget process.
4. It is now appropriate to carry over these resources into the FY 1980-81 Bureau of Economic Development budget in order to continue support for the programs for which the funds were originally appropriated.
