

ORDINANCE NO. **150215**

An Ordinance increasing appropriations in the Bureau of Economic Development and the Bureau of Planning in the amount of \$30,000 each for the purpose of appropriating contract funds for the continuation of the METRO contract with the City of Portland; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149237, the City of Portland authorized acceptance of a contract in the amount of \$45,000 with METRO in which the City of Portland agreed to carry out certain air quality projects.
2. Of the contract amount of \$45,000, expenditures during FY 1979-80 totalled \$9,000, leaving a balance of \$30,000, as shown below:
 

a. Total contract award	\$45,000
b. Total expenditures, FY 1979-80	(9,000)
c. Balance of contract available	36,000
d. Appropriated in FY 1980-81 budget	(6,000)
e. Amount available for FY 1980-81 carryover	<u>\$30,000</u>
3. It was not possible to estimate the amount of contract award available at the end of FY 1979-80 during the FY 1980-81 budget process.
4. It is now appropriate to carry over these resources into the FY 1980-81 budgets of the Bureau of Economic Development and the Bureau of Planning, in order to continue support of the programs for which the funds were originally appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The FY 1980-81 budget is hereby amended as follows:
