

ORDINANCE NO. **150216**

An Ordinance increasing resources and requirements in the Federal Grants and General Funds in the amount of \$106,602, for the purpose of appropriating grant funds to the Bureau of Economic Development for the continuation of programs under a federal air quality technical assistance demonstration grant award to the City of Portland; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 147333, the City of Portland authorized acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$499,697 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the United States Department of Commerce, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and the United States Department of Transportation to aid in air quality planning.
2. Of the total grant award, expenditures during FY 1978-79 and FY 1979-80 totalled \$353,969, leaving a balance of \$145,728, as shown below:

a. Total grant award	\$499,697
b. Total expenditures, FY 1978-79	(21,974)
c. Total expenditures, FY 1979-80	(331,995)
d. Balance of grant award available	145,728
e. Appropriated in FY 1980-81 budget	(39,126)
f. Amount available for FY 1980-81 carryover	<u>\$106,602</u>
3. It was not possible to estimate the amount of the grant award available at the end of FY 1979-80 during the FY 1980-81 budget process.
4. It is now appropriate to carry over these resources into the FY 1980-81 Bureau of Economic Development budget in order to continue support of the programs for which the funds were originally appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
