ORDINANCE NO. **150218**

An Ordinance authorizing a compromise settlement in the amount of \$12,000 to be paid to claimant A. A. Ambulance Service of Portland, Inc. for property damage to claimant's ambulance which resulted from a vehicle collision between claimant's employee and a city employee, at the intersection of N.E. Fremont Street and N.E. Union Avenue, Portland, Oregon, subject to the approval of the Multnomah County Circuit Court, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- (1) A. A. Ambulance Service of Portland, Inc., Portland, Oregon, has made a claim for property damage and other business losses resulting from a vehicle collision between its employee and a city employee at the intersection of N.E. Fremont Street and N.E. Union Avenue, Portland, Oregon, on October 4, 1977;
- (2) The claim has been investigated by the City's Risk Management Division and defended by the City Attorney's office. It appears that there is substantial risk that the City might be found liable and that it is prudent to settle the claim in order to avoid full liability therefor and further costs of defense and litigation;
- (3) The Commissioner of Finance and Administration and the City Attorney recommend that the claim be settled for \$12,000, subject to claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney;
- (4) Pursuant to ORS 30.290, the settlement of this claim is subject to the approval of the Multnomah County Circuit Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- (a) Subject to the approval of the Multnomah County Circuit Court pursuant to ORS 30.290, the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant in the amount of \$12,000 made payable to A. A. Ambulance Service of Portland, Inc. and Frank J. Susak, Attorney, its attorney, as settlement in full of all claims for damages upon receipt of a release approved by the City Attorney.

**ORDINANCE No.**

Section 2. The Council declares:

That an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
