

ORDINANCE NO.

150219

An Ordinance increasing resources and requirements in the Federal Grants and General Funds in the amount of \$128,776, for the purpose of appropriating grant funds to the Bureau of Economic Development for the continuation of the Industrial Site Development Program under an Economic Development Administration grant award to the City of Portland; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 147979, the City of Portland authorized a grant application to the Economic Development Administration for funding of the Industrial Site Development Program. This grant was awarded to the City by EDA in the amount of \$1,303,000.
2. Of the total grant award of \$1,303,000, expenditures during FY 1979-80 totalled \$44,724, leaving a balance of \$1,258,276, as shown below:
 

a. Total grant award	\$1,303,000
b. Total expenditures, FY 1979-80	(44,724)
c. Balance of grant award available	1,258,276
d. Appropriated in FY 1980-81 budget	(1,129,500)
e. Amount available for FY 1980-81 carryover	\$128,776
3. It was not possible to estimate the amount of the grant award available at the end of FY 1979-80 during the FY 1980-81 budget process.
4. It is now appropriate to carry over these resources into the FY 1980-81 Bureau of Economic Development budget in order to continue support of the program for which the funds were originally appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
