

ORDINANCE NO. 150220

An Ordinance transferring appropriations within the General Fund in the amount of \$345, for the purpose of appropriating contract funds to the Bureau of Economic Development for the continuation of the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality contract with the City of Portland; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 146812, the City of Portland authorized the acceptance of a contract in the amount of \$15,000 with the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality in which the City of Portland agreed to carry out certain professional services related to air quality planning.
2. Of the contract amount of \$15,000, expenditures during FY 1978-79 and FY 1979-80 totalled \$14,655, leaving a balance of \$345, as shown below:

a. Total contract award	\$15,000
b. Total expenditures, FY 1978-79	(494)
c. Total expenditures, FY 1979-80	(14,161)
d. Balance of contract available	345
e. Appropriated in FY 1980-81 budget	0
f. Amount available for FY 1980-81 carryover	<u>\$345</u>
3. It was not possible to estimate the amount of contract award available at the end of FY 1979-80 during the FY 1980-81 budget process.
4. It is now appropriate to carry over these resources into the FY 1980-81 Bureau of Economic Development budget in order to continue support of the programs for which the funds were originally appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Amendment of the FY 1980-81 budget is authorized, with a transfer of appropriations as follows:
