ORDINANCE NO. 190394

*Pay property damage claim of Lucas Kaufman in the sum of \$7,103 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Lucas Kaufman has filed a property damage claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau on January 7, 2021.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$7,103 with the amount of \$2,103 still due, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a) The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$2,103 made payable to Lucas Kaufman.
- b) Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
