ORDINANCE NO. 150234

An Ordinance amending Title 7, Business Licenses, of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, increasing the penalty for delinquent payments, and exempting from the requirements of Title 7, those people who receive income from renting or leasing less than ten dwelling units.

The City of Portland ordains:

4.

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Section 7.10.010 of the City Code provides for a penalty for people who fail to pay their license fees when the same become due, but said penalty has proved to be insufficient to accomplish its goal of inducing people to promptly pay their license fees and therefore the penalty for late payment of license fees should be increased in order that prompt payment will be encouraged.
- Section 7.06.030 of the City Code exempts from the requirements of the business license law those persons who receive income from renting or leasing residental real property if the owner rents or leases less than four dwelling units. The exemption should be changed to exempt people who are renting or leasing less than ten such units.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Section 7.10.010(a) of Chapter 7.10, Violations, of Title 7, Business Licenses of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon is hereby amended and shall read hereafter as follows:
 - "7.10.010 Penalty and interest on failure to pay fee. (a) If a person (1) fails to file a correct application at the time required by or under the Business License Law or (2) fails to pay a fee at the time the same becomes due, unless it is shown that such failure is due to reasonable cause and not due to willful neglect, there shall be added to the amount of fee required to be shown on the application a penalty of twenty percent of the amount of such fee, but not less than twenty dollars, if the failure is for not more than one month, with an additional ten percent for each additional month or fraction thereof during which failure continues, provided that such additional penalties shall in no event exceed 50 percent of the fee."
- b. Section 7.06.030 (3)(D) of Chapter 7.06, License Requirements and Applications, of Title 7, Business Licenses of the Code of the City of Portland is hereby amended and shall read hereafter as follows:

"D. The renting or leasing of residential real property, provided that the beneficial owner of such real property does not rent or lease more than nine dwelling units within the City, and that such renting or leasing is unrelated to any other licensed business of such beneficial owner."
