**ORDINANCE NO. 190413**

\*Pay property damage claim of The Hertz Corporation in the sum of \$9,693 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving Portland Fire & Rescue (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Hertz Corporation has filed a property damage claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving Portland Fire & Rescue on September 10, 2020.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$9,692.92, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- A. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$9,692.92 made payable to The Hertz Corporation.
- B. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
