

ORDINANCE NO. **150883**

An ordinance accepting a grant from the Department of Energy's Alcohol Fuels Technology Program in the amount of \$4,500; amending the fiscal year 1980-81 City budget by increasing the resources and requirements in the Federal Grants and Fleet Operating Funds by \$4,500, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. In April 1980 the Bureau of Fleet Management applied for a grant from the Department of Energy (DOE) to convert three (3) City vehicles to run on 100% methanol alcohol.
2. On October 31, 1980 the Bureau of Fleet Management was informed by DOE that our proposal was accepted and that a grant award in the amount of \$4,500 was available.
3. The methanol test program will be operated for one (1) year and will be administered by Fleet Management. During that period quarterly performance reports will be made to DOE.
4. The project will be administered by Fleet Management with existing personnel. No City funds will be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Portland, accept the grant in the amount of \$4,500 from the Department of Energy.
- b. The 1980-81 City Budget is hereby amended to increase appropriations as follows:
