

ORDINANCE NO. 151040

An Ordinance transferring \$16,000 within the General Fund from the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Fire, Logistics Division, for the emergency repair and refurbishing of Fire Boat 3, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That Fire Boat 3 (Spencer) is currently in drydock for emergency repairs due to a crack in its hull. That over the past three years such emergency repairs have been reoccurring and are primarily attributed to the design of the Spencer.
2. That the Bureau of Fire currently intends to submit a \$39,000 request within its FY 1981-82 Budget proposal for the refurbishing of Fire Boat 3. The proposed project will prevent the reoccurrence of hull cracks and improve the operational effectiveness of Boat 3.
3. That emergency repairs currently required to place Fire Boat 3 back in service are estimated to cost \$5,000. Such an expenditure would neither decrease the Bureau's FY 81-82 request or prevent the reoccurrence of similar problems in the future.
4. That over the past four fiscal years the Bureau of Fire has expended \$41,000 or an average of \$10,000 per fiscal year for the repair of Boat 3.
5. That the Fire Bureau recommends as an alternative to emergency repairs, partially commencing with the refurbishing of Fire Boat 3 in the current fiscal year at an estimated cost of \$16,000.
6. That the Bureau of Fire does not have sufficient appropriation for these expenditures thereby necessitating a transfer from the General Fund Operating Contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a) The City of Portland FY 1980-81 Budget is amended as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would deprive the City of the benefits derived from the services provided by Fire Boat 3; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
